Competence

- Our programs are certified under rigorous standards of the Indiana Coalition against Domestic Violence. Our staff are carefully trained and supervised.
- We have been recognized as experts in the Duluth Model and have lead national trainings in adult Domestic Violence intervention since 1995.
- Our youth staff are certified in the "WhyTry?" Curriculum.

Accountability

- We are careful to report to the criminal justice system and the juvenile justice system when the defendant has re-offended or when he or she fails to follow through with court-ordered responsibilities.
- We work closely with the legal system to provide admissible documentation and to appear in court as witnesses when needed.
- We are open about both successes and failures and are willing to give accurate data to the community about our outcomes.

- We make victim safety and advocacy our priorities and make every effort including partner outreach and safety planning for partners of the program participant.
